INTRODUCTION

Hotfix 50520 fixes several issues discovered in previous releases.

Important: Before installing this hotfix, make sure that WebCT Vista Service Pack 3.0.3 has been installed. You must also install hotfixes 43010, 43070, 43500, and 50240. (Each of the listed hotfixes is dependent on the previous one, so they must be installed in this order.)

Authentication	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • CR082707 • CR083203 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • When a user was authenticated via LDAP, Vista did not close the LDAP connection once authentication was complete. This issue has been fixed; LDAP connections are closed immediately after authentication is complete. • Calling the getSsoUrl from an outbound AuthenticationModule request (proxy tool request) would not return the correct SSO URL. Attempting to use the returned URL to perform inbound authentication would fail. This issue has been fixed; getSsoUrl now returns the correct URL.
Calendar	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • CR083193 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Calendar entries in restricted courses could be accessed via Create Printable View. This issue has been fixed; calendar entries in restricted courses no longer appear in the printable view.
Gradebook	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • CR082709 • CR082713 • CR082711 • CR082714 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • When editing an overridden value in a calculated or letter grade column, if the instructor clicks Revert to Original and clears the formula, the value reverts to the previous override value instead of the (original) calculated value. This causes errors when calculating partial results. This issue has been fixed; reverting a calculated column value always changes the value back to the calculated value. • If a calculated column's formula contains a reference to another calculated column that does not have a formula, partial results would not be shown for the first column. This issue has been fixed; partial results are displayed correctly for calculated columns that contain references to calculated columns that do not have formulae. • In certain situations, clicking Save in the Edit Members screen would cause to be re-saved as override values. This would occur if the calculated value was a repeating decimal or contained more decimal places than defined for the column. Vista would round the value to an appropriate number and cause it to be overridden. As a result, changes to the column formula would not be reflected in the values because they were manually overridden. This issue has been fixed; clicking Save in Edit members no longer causes the values to be modified. • If a column label contained commas, the column could not be referred to in calculated columns. This issue has been fixed; columns with commas in their labels can be referred to in calculated columns.

User Manager	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• CR082705	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• In certain situations, it was possible for a user to enroll as a role that would conflict with the user's other enrollments. For example, an Institution Administration was able to enroll as a Student. This issue has been fixed; each user's enrollments are checked before enrolling in a new role/learning context.
