Backup and Restore	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • CR096862 • CR095901 • CR083698 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • When backing up multiple sections at the same time, occasionally, the sections could not be backed up. This has been fixed. • If a section backup contained corrupted enrollment data for one or more users, the section backup could not be restored successfully. An example of corrupted enrollment data would be a user who is enrolled in conflicting roles, such as the student and instructor roles. This has been fixed so that corrupted enrollment data is corrected during the restoration process. • If a section backup contained an assignment that was assigned to a student multiple times due to data corruption, not all submissions associated with the duplicated assignment were restored. This has been fixed so that all submissions are now restored. You can use the following public utility to delete submissions that are not applicable: fixDupAssignmentSubmissions_3.0.x.50260.
Browser Checker	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • CR095123 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A non-existent page was referenced in the Browser Checker. For most users, this resulted in large numbers of <i>Page Not Found (404)</i> errors in the webserver log. However, for users who customized their error page to automatically log out when a <i>Page Not Found</i> error occurs, this resulted in users being logged out unexpectedly. This issue has been fixed.
Content Import/Export	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • CR069695 • CR089210 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A new log file, enterpriseExport.log, has been created for information and error logging that occurs when grade information is exported using the System Integration API (SI API). This information appeared in the web.log file, along with all other logged events, making it difficult to identify quickly. The new log file is stored in the logs/systemintegration directory. • Users who work with portals that rely on the System Integration API (SI API) to acquire the XML for the Homepage will notice a performance improvement.
Course Homepage	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • CR095803 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If a course contained legacy data, course items could not appear on the Homepage. This occurred because the legacy data was missing a required attribute that was not part of a previous Service Pack. This has been fixed; all Homepage course items now appear, even if the items do not have the required attribute.
Discussions	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • CR094598 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Performance has been improved when accessing Discussion topics with a large number of messages.

General	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • CR095537 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • After installing Service Pack 5, an irrelevant error message was logged when the server was re-started. This error message is no longer being logged.
Templates	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • CR095462 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Service Pack 5 introduced an issue which removed learning groups when a template was reassigned to a course. This issue has been fixed.
